### 1. Medium-Term Outlook in Germany: Methodology




Estimations/projection of potential output are particularly relevant in the context of the...

- ... "Debt Break":
  - Starting in 2016 the structural deficit on the federal level is not allowed to exceed 0,35% of nominal GDP (until 2016: gradual decrease to 0,35%).
- A cyclical component allows higher / lower net lending in times of negative / positive output gaps.
- Relevant for medium term budgetary planning:
  - Medium-term outlook of GDP (and its components),
  - Output potential (and output gaps).

- Estimating potential based on methodological framework of COM.
  - No equal treatment, modification of method of COM
  - Examples: Gross capital stock, univariate models...
- Potential as econometric anchor for medium-term outlook of the demand side of the economy.
  - Output gap closure rule: Gap closed at end of projection horizon (linear decrease),
  - Simple extrapolation of trends.





#### **Production Potential and GDP**













#### **Contribution to Trend Hours Worked**














#### **Output Gap in Germany**




### Impact of the crisis on Germany's output potential






#### Structural Unemployment, Participation and Hours Worked





Working Age Population Projection 2009, Federal Statistical Office (rhs)


#### **Demography: (Working Age) Population**
